Start your child's journey with NC InCK

1 Meet your Care Manager

You have the option to work with a Care Manager, who can support you in achieving your child's health and well-being goals and coordinating a team to support your family.



Spend more time with your child and less time coordinating your child's care.

2 Tell them what you need

In collaboration with your team, you will create a plan for your child. This plan helps your child's team members know your top goals for your child's health and well-being.



Enjoy peace of mind knowing you have a trusted team to rely on to support your child's health goals.

3 Check-in on progress

Meet with your Care Manager every three months to share your child's progress and discuss any unmet or emerging needs to support your child's health and wellbeing.
