

## **Doula Eligibility & Attestation**

Doulas who enroll with WellCare of North Carolina must meet one of the two pathways to be eligible to enroll to participate in the doula Value Added Benefit:

Option 1: Experience Pathway:	
Attestation of having attended at least 10 live births	Provide 2-3 written client testimonials or professional letters of recommendation that include cultural humility/competency experience
Attestation of having provided labor and birth support for at least 2 years	Proof of liability insurance, copy to be attached
Option 2: Training Pathway:	
Attestation of attending 3 live births	Proof of liability insurance, copy to be attached
Certificate of completion of at least 16 hours of training that covers the following	<ul> <li>Core Competencies:</li> <li>Basic Newborn Care</li> <li>Childbirth education</li> <li>Client self-advocacy and empowerment techniques</li> <li>Common medical interventions: risks, benefits, and decision-making</li> <li>Coping strategies and nonmedical comfort measures during labor and birth</li> <li>Lactation support, education and infant feeding</li> <li>Essential Equity Competencies:</li> <li>Community resource referrals</li> <li>Cultural awareness/humility and crosscultural communication</li> <li>Health equity in medical field and maternal health disparities</li> </ul>
